

Beginning the week of August 15, Carnegie Mellon University is implementing card-swipe print-release stations to manage public printing in the University Libraries and in Computing Services Clusters.

Printing quota system, costs and no-refund policy were negotiated and agreed between Computing Services and Student Advisory Council. Please direct any comments to the Computing Services Help Center at 412-268-HELP or advisor@andrew.cmu.edu.

- Printing citations from the Libraries' CAMEO-ONLY (library catalog) workstations is FREE.
- Carnegie Mellon students, faculty and staff have generous printing quotas encoded on their Carnegie Mellon ID cards.
- Printing costs for Non-Affiliated (Guest) users is \$.05 per page for one- or two-sided B&W or \$.70 per page for color.
- Print one- or two-sided pages for the same cost at any printer where duplex is an option.
- *No refunds for printing.*

Carnegie Mellon students, faculty and staff

- Printing quota per semester is 800 one- or two-sided B&W pages. Color printing uses quota 14 times faster than B&W printing.
- If you use up your semester quota, you may pay for additional printing with CampusXpress or PlaidCa\$h.

Non-Affiliated (Guest) users

- Pay for printing with PlaidCa\$h debit cards.
- Buy PlaidCa\$h from vending machines in Hunt Library or the University Center Lower Level, or at circulation desks in Engineering & Science and Mellon Institute Libraries.
- PlaidCa\$h cards may be 'recharged' and reused indefinitely.
